

110 institutions around the world received support through the USAID-funded YOUTH EXCEL program. 97% of the organizations reported stronger programs, and 91% reported receiving funding from new donors.

AFRICAN YOUTH ENTREPRENEURS



GLOBAL OPPORTUNITIES YOUTH NETWORK


